NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 - 2020.
- 1.2 To encourage boats to take penalties afloat, rules observers may blow a whistle when they see what they believe to be a breach of a rule.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Sharpie class and sailors who are members of a YT/AS affiliated Club and the Tasmanian Sharpie Association. Interstate visitors are eligible to enter if they are members of their State Sharpie Association. Interstate visitors are not eligible to be awarded the Tasmanian Championship.

4. Entry

- 4.1 Entries must be completed and paid on the online entry: [Enter Sharpie Tas Championship here](#)
- 4.2 The closing date and time by which the Entry must be received by the RYCT is 17:00 Wednesday 11 March 2020. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority up to 17:00 on Friday 13 March for the payment of an additional fee.
- 4.3 Entry fee is \$75. Late fee: additional \$20.



5. Insurance

All competing boats are required to have a current Certificate of Insurance for the period of the regatta including Third Party Liability and Public Liability Insurance of not less than AUD5,000,000 for any one incident.

6. Schedule of Races and Events

Saturday 14 March 2020 Sailors Briefing 09:30
..... First Warning Signal 11:00
Sunday 15 March 2020 First Warning Signal 10:00
No Warning Signal will be made after 1500 Sunday 15 March 2020.

Races are to be conducted back to back; the warning signal for the second or subsequent races will be made as soon as possible after the previous race has been completed.

8. Sailing Instructions

Will be available upon registration at the event.

9. Official Notice Board

Will be located at the RYCT OTB Centre.

10. Racing Area

The racing area shall be the waters of the River Derwent in the vicinity of the RYCT.

11. Courses

As described in the Sailing Instructions. The courses will be a mix of triangle and windward/leeward legs.

12. Scoring System

12.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series. A maximum of six (6) races will be run.

12.2 When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded in accordance with Table 1.

Table 1

Number of Entrants	3	4 to 5	6 or more
Prizes	1 st Only	1 st & 2 nd	1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd

Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Tasmanian Sharpie Association.
